Registration/Check-in

The ILYA and THECLUBSPOT.COM will be the official registration sites. <u>Registration link ILYA</u> <u>members</u> in good standing can compete in the regatta. The registration fee is \$105 per boat. Junior skippers age 25 and under as of June 14, 2019 will have their entry fee waived provided, they are National C Scow Sailing Association members at the moment of registration. However, this entry fee waiver does not include late fees, lunches or dinners. Boats not registered by **July 5**th will be imposed a \$20 late fee. In-person registration and check-in is at regatta headquarters (Okauchee Lake Yacht Club) from 4:30-8pm on Friday (7/19) and 7:30-8:45am on Saturday (7/21). Early registration is encouraged. Regatta HQ is the Okauchee Lake Yacht Club.

Launching/Mooring

Friday (7/19): between 4:30p.m. and 8p.m. | Saturday (7/20): 7:30AM-8:45AM

All sailboats will be launched at regatta headquarters. There will be volunteers, beverages and taxi boats available. This is a wet sail regatta so please bring a mooring and plan for water depth of 10-20 feet. Boats can be moored in front of the yacht club or pre-arranged private residences. Power boats can be launched (no overnight storage) at OLYC or the DNR launch on Road T in downtown Okauchee. Spectator boats will be available.

Saturday- Please join us for a Dinner Party (7/20) hosted by Okauchee Lake Yacht Club for all competitors and their families. The cost for the meal and party is \$30 per person. Following dinner, there will be a live performance by the After Hours band.

<u>Gear</u>

Regatta gear will be available for pre-purchase online with registration. Additionally, a limited number of items and sizes will be available at regatta HQ. Quality Cotton short-sleeved and Tech long-sleeved will be regatta apparel. Online gear is available thru 7/5

Lunches

Lunches ~ Four(4) lunches per registered adult sailboat(2 Sat. & 2 Sun.) are included in registration. Lunches for juniors, additional crew and spectators can be purchased for \$10 per meal. It is encouraged to purchase extra lunches during registration. A limited number of extra lunches will be available for purchase on-site. Lunches will be catered food.

Trailer/Additional Parking

Trailer parking will be at the <u>Stone Bank Elementary School</u> on the north side of county hwy K. No trailer parking will be available at Regatta HQ. Overflow vehicle parking will also be at stone bank school. Car pooling and/or vehicle drop off is encouraged to accommodate parking for everyone. No parking is allowed on Breezy Point Rd throughout the duration of the regatta. If overflow parking is required a shuttle will be provided. More information to be provided at registration/check-in. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation!

Take-out

Following the completion of the regatta. Take out will occur in opposite flow of launching. Takeout will be organized by trailer order. After derigged trailers and boats will be dropped back off at Stone Bank School and tow vehicle can return for awards.
